4 SEC. 14. COMMITTEE ON RULES AND ADMINISTRATION.

(a) GENERAL AUTHORITY.—In carrying out its powers, duties, and functions under the Standing Rules of the
Senate, in accordance with its jurisdiction under rule XXV
8 of the Standing Rules of the Senate, including holding
9 hearings, reporting such hearings, and making investiga10 tions as authorized by paragraphs 1 and 8 of rule XXVI

of the Standing Rules of the Senate, the Committee on
 Rules and Administration is authorized from March 1,
 2025, through February 28, 2027, in its discretion, to—
 (1) make expenditures from the contingent fund
 of the Senate;

6 (2) employ personnel; and

7 (3) with the prior consent of the Government
8 department or agency concerned and the Committee
9 on Rules and Administration, use on a reimbursable
10 or nonreimbursable basis the services of personnel of
11 any such department or agency.

12 (b) EXPENSES FOR PERIOD ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 13 2025.—The expenses of the committee for the period March 1, 2025, through September 30, 2025, under this 14 15 section shall not exceed \$2,354,135, of which amount— 16 (1) not to exceed \$200,000 may be expended 17 for the procurement of the services of individual con-18 sultants, or organizations thereof (as authorized by 19 section 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act 20 of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4301(i))); and

(2) not to exceed \$40,000 may be expended for
the training of the professional staff of such committee (under procedures specified by section 202(j)
of that Act).

(c) EXPENSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 PERIOD.—
 The expenses of the committee for the period October 1,
 2025, through September 30, 2026, under this section
 shall not exceed \$4,035,660, of which amount—

5 (1) not to exceed \$200,000 may be expended
6 for the procurement of the services of individual con7 sultants, or organizations thereof (as authorized by
8 section 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act
9 of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4301(i))); and
