Bradley A. Smith is the founder and Chairman of the Institute for Free Speech, a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to promoting and defending American citizens' First Amendment political speech rights.

Professor Smith is the Josiah H. Blackmore II/Shirley M. Nault Professor of Law at Capital University in Columbus, Ohio. He has held prior visiting appointments at Princeton University and West Virginia University, and been recognized as one of the 10 most cited legal scholars in the field of election law, with a particular emphasis on campaign finance.

From June 2000 until August 2005, Professor Smith served as Commissioner of the Federal Election Commission, including as Vice Chairman in 2003 and Chairman in 2004.

He is a cum laude graduate of both Kalamazoo College and Harvard Law School.
